Day 1

Welcome

Upon your arrival at <u>Luxor airport / Luxor train station</u>, you will be met and assisted by <u>Your Egypt Tours</u> representative, then you will be guided by your Egyptologist tour guide for a tour in Luxor to visit the Valley of the Kings, <u>Hatshepsut Temple</u>, Memnon Colossi and Karnak Temples. Later you will be transferred from Luxor to Esna for embarking on your Nile Boat where you will be welcomed by the crew on board. Overnight in Esna on board your Nile boat.

Day 2

Edfu Temple

Whilst sleeping, we gently sail on the way to Edfu: enjoy breakfast at your leisure, visit Edfu Temple by horse carriage, one of the largest and most intact of Egypt's monuments. Two beautiful granite statues of the Falcon God Horus flank the entrance. After you visit the temple, either ride or walk through the bazaar, this is an extensive bazaar where you can barter for souvenirs, spices, and perfumes. We will then set sail for our private island El Fouza where we will disembark for dinner served to you on the edge of the Nile.

Day 3

Temple of Gebel el Silsila

We set off for the relaxing journey to the temple of Gebel el Silsila, another of our less frequented destinations. You will be amazed as we tie up alongside the Speos of Hormheb. If possible dinner will be served on the grounds of the illuminated temple or on the upper deck of the Boat whilst soaking up the tranquil atmosphere with music to match the mood.

Day 4

Kom Ombo

Breakfast at your leisure as we sail on to Kom Ombo. Listen to the sounds of the water buffalo as they wade in the shallow water beside the banks of the Nile, the Donkeys as they go about their day-to-day business, and the various bird life of the river. Here we visit the Greco Roman <u>Temple at Kom Ombo</u>. The temple building is symmetrical with two entrances 's two halls and two sanctuaries dedicated to the Falcon God Haroeris (Horus the Elder) and the Crocodile God Sobek. Lunch will be served as we head for a small island where we will moor for the

evening and enjoy dinner at this atmospheric location.

Day 5

Temple of Philae

Sailing to Aswan. We should arrive around 10 am, giving you plenty of time to visit some of the highlights such as the <u>Temple of Philae</u> and the Souk and Unfinished Obelisk You will have lots of time to prepare for our EGYPTIAN EVENING OF FUN, with <u>Traditional Egyptian food</u>, Arabic Music.
