We arrive at the magnificent Temple of Edfu just before daybreak. This outstanding work from a bygone era provides a unique perspective on history. Horus, the falcon god's wealth, is kept here.

We visit the famed Kom Ombo after a hearty breakfast. There are two temples, as may be seen. Horus the Elder, also known as Haroeis, the Falcon God, has a temple dedicated to him. The Crocodile, Sobek, the cosmic creator and fertility deity, represents the opposing side. Enjoy a delicious meal, fascinating historical sites, and an exciting evening to conclude off an exceptional day.

Day 4

Aswan - High Dam and Philae Temple

As we approach closer to Aswan, the beautiful Nile waves swish past us. Enjoy your meal as you prepare to say goodbye to your journey.
