Day 1

Arrival | Cairo International Airport

Day 2

Giza Pyramids, Sphinx and Sakkara

After breakfast, you will enjoy an excursion to the <u>Giza Pyramids</u> of Cheops, Chephren, and Mycerinus. Then proceed to visit the <u>Great</u> <u>Sphinx</u> with a lion's body, dating back to the time of Chephren. The Giza Plateau is about 30 minutes from Cairo, where your Egyptologist guide will provide a fascinating introduction to the three pyramids: Cheops, Khafre, and Menakaure.

Your final stop is <u>Sakkara</u> which is home to Egypt's oldest pyramid. <u>The Step Pyramid</u> was built in 2650 B.C. After your guide provides a brief history of this famous pyramid, you will have free time to explore it independently. In addition, you will have the chance to visit a Papyrus Institute to see how this famous artwork is made and have a chance to purchase genuine items if you wish. After the conclusion of your tour, you will drive back to your hotel for drop-off.

Day 3

Egyptian Museum, Citadel of Salah el-Din & Khan el Khalili Bazaar

Take advantage of your free time to wander the streets and browse the vast shops, testing your haggling skills with local vendors for a treasured souvenir. Don't forget to stop for a refreshing cup of tea at the renowned coffee shop "El Fishawy."
