Day 2

Kom Ombo – Edfu & Onward

Following a hearty breakfast, we visit the well-known Kom Ombo. There are two temples, as can be seen. A temple honors Horus the

Elder, also called the Falcon God, Haroeis. The other side is represented by the Crocodile, Sobek, the cosmic creator and fertility deity. To end an absolutely incredible day, take in a delicious dinner, intriguing historical sites, and an entertaining evening.

Day 4

Aswan - High Dam and Philae Temple
