This historical location offers a unique viewpoint on the past. Horus, the most prosperous falcon god, resides here.

Following a substantial breakfast, we proceed to the renowned Kom Ombo. A temple is devoted to Horus the Elder, also known as Haroeis, the Falcon God. The Crocodile, Sobek, the cosmic creator and fertility deity, represents the opposing side. After enjoying a filling supper and exploring a few fascinating historical locations, end the day with a spectacular evening.

Day 4

Aswan - High Dam and Philae Temple

We arrive at Aswan to the sparkling waters of the Nile. Savor your breakfast and be ready to say goodbye to your adventures.

Our program includes visits to the magnificent High Dam, the unfinished Obelisk, and the renowned Philae Temple. After a delicious meal, relax and take in the surroundings.
