Sail to Luxor and take an excursion to the royal cemetery for 62 Pharaohs. Relax at Sharm El Sheikh and start your adventure in Petra, Jerusalem, and Jordan.

Day 1

Arrival Cairo

Your tour manager will meet and assist you upon your arrival at Cairo International Airport. After that, you will be transferred to your hotel in Cairo by a private air-conditioned vehicle for check-in. Upon arrival at the hotel, he will check you in and give detailed information concerning your tomorrow trip. Overnight in Cairo. Welcome Drink

Day 2

Pyramids Tour

Breakfast at your hotel in Cairo and then met your guide who will accompany you to Giza Plateau to visit the Great Pyramids of Cheops, Chefren, and Mykerinus- the Famous Sphinx and Valley temple facing the great statue. Additional visit to the Solar Boat in front of Cheops Pyramid (extra ticket on spot). Then proceed to the Sakkara area to visit Sakkara Complex and the first pyramid ever built (Djoser Pyramid). Overnight in Cairo. Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Day 3

Cairo Tours

Check out after breakfast and then you will be escorted by your private guide to visit Egyptian Museum, and Treasures room for the child king Tutankhamen, alongside many other fascinating artifacts. Additional visit to the mummies room at the museum (extra ticket on spot). Continue to Coptic Cairo to visit the Hanging Church Ben Ezra Synagogue. Combining fascinating history with shopping in a lively Khan El Khalili Bazaar, this dates back to 1382. In the evening transfer to Cairo Airport for a flight to Aswan. Overnight in Aswan. Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Day 4

Trip to Abu Simbel Temples

Breakfast at your hotel in; Aswan, then at 11:00 am tour to enjoy a tour to one of Egypt's top tourist attractions, Abu Simbel temples, which were originally carved out of the mountainside during the reign of Pharaoh Ramesses II in the 13th century BC, as a lasting monument to himself and his queen Nefertari. From Aswan to Abu Simbel is about a 03 hours and a half drive one way. Overnight in Aswan. Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Day 5

Aswan Nile Cruise Sightseeing

Breakfast at your hotel in Aswan. Then transfer to embark on your Nile River Cruise before Lunch at 11:00 a.m, then enjoy visiting the world-famous High Dam, The awesome Philae Temple, which is devoted to the two goddesses Isis and Hathor, and the largest known ancient obelisk, located in the northern region of the stone quarries of ancient Egypt, the Unfinished Obelisk. Dinner on board and overnight in Aswan. Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 6

Edfu and Kom Ombo Temple

Sail to Kom Ombo, have breakfast on board, and Visit the Temple shared by two gods Sobek and Haeroris in Kom Ombo. Sail to Edfu, lunch on board after that Visit the best-preserved cult temple in Egypt, Horus Temple in Edfu. Take afternoon tea during sailing to Esna. Dinner and overnight on board. Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 7

Luxor West Bank Tours

Sail to Luxor, have breakfast on board then visit the West Bank, take an excursion to the royal cemetery for 62 Pharaohs, Valley of the Kings, then to the mortuary Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, which was built by the architects of the New Kingdom Pharaoh Hatshepsut in the 15th century BC at El-Deir El-Bahari and the Colossi Memnon. Lunch on board. Enjoy afternoon tea during sailing. Dinner on board Overnight in Luxor. Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

Day 8

Luxor East Bank

Breakfast on board, Disembark from your Nile cruise after breakfast at 08:00 a.m. Then transfer to visit Karnak and Luxor Temples. Then transfer to Luxor Airport for a flight to Sharm El Sheikh. Most flights are indirect flights via Cairo Airport. Upon arrival at Sharm. Transfer to your hotel and overnight in Sharm. Meals: Breakfast

Day 9

Sharm El Sheikh

Breakfast with a free day at your hotel and on the beach in Sharm El Sheikh with optional excursions available and overnight stay. Meals: Breakfast

Day 10

Sharm to Jordan

Breakfast box from your hotel. You will be met and assisted by our company representative at your hotel in Sharm El Sheikh and transferred by air-

conditioned van class to Taba Border the journey takes about 3 hours drive. Then transfer from the Taba border to Arava Border (Taxi fees and taxes to be paid locally by yourselves) to cross to the Jordanian side, where you will be met by another representative who will assist you through immigration, and then you will depart; Aqaba for Petra. Along the way, you will stop to explore Wadi Rum, where you will enjoy an exhilarating 4X4 ride visiting the Wadi Um Eshreen, the Moving Sand, Al Khazali, Abu Aineh, and Rum Mountain. We will see the trail of the Lawrence of Arabia and the famous Red Mountains. Afterward, we proceed north to the spectacular lost city of Petra. Overnight in Petra. Meals: Breakfast

Day 11

Petra Tour

After breakfast departure for a day tour to the red rose city Petra, Jordan's the biggest attraction. Petra was established around the 6th century B.C. by the Nabataean Arabs, a nomadic tribe who settled in the area and founded a commercial empire. Upon arrival, you will begin the trip on horseback to the Siq, the canyon, and then on foot, until you reach the most beautiful monument: the Treasury. Among other monuments you will see are the Street of Facades, the Royal Tombs, and Pharaohs Castle. In the afternoon drive to Amman hotel for overnight. Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Day 12

Jerusalem Tour

At 7:00 am pick up from your Amman hotel to head for the Allenby Bridge/King Hussein Border to leave Jordan. Your tour guide welcomes you, then drive via the Judean desert to the Holy City of Jerusalem. We start with a panoramic view from the Mount of Olives and walk down to the Garden of Gethsemane and the Church of All Nations. In the old city, we view the Wailing Wall, which represents the last remnants of the Jewish Temple, destroyed by the Romans. If open to visitors, we ascend to the Temple Mount to look at the famous Dome of the Rock. Then we continue to the Via Dolorosa, which leads us to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre, where Jesus Christ was crucified and buried. Back to Amman. Overnight in a hotel in Amman. Meals: Breakfast, Lunch

Day 13

Amman City Tour

Breakfast at the hotel, then you will be transferred to start your tour in Amman to enjoy the Roman Theatre, Archaeological and Folklore Museums, and King Abdullah Mosque. Proceed to Jerash, the best example of a Roman provincial city in the whole Middle East, Nymphaeum, North theatre, Artemis temple, St. Cosmos and Demeanors church, and youth theatre. Back to your hotel and Overnight in Amman.

Day 14

Final Departure

After breakfast, transfer to Amman Airport for final departure. Meals: Breakfast
