Pyramids and Egyptian Museum:

You will get to know how Egyptians used to live long ago or even visit some places where they worshipped their gods or maybe listen carefully to a part of their history that took place hundreds of years ago.

Old Cairo and Khan El Khalili Bazaar:

Your second day in Cairo starts with a visit to Old Cairo, which is a historical area containing interesting places. One of the oldest Coptic Christian churches of Egypt is found here, which is called the Hanging Church. And explore the majestic Ben Ezra Synagogue. Then we head to the Mosque of Amr ibn al-As, which was built first in Egypt's history and reflects Islamic architecture. And more to explore like the Alabaster and Ibn Tulun mosques.
