Day 1

Arrival | Cairo

Day 3

The Great Pyramids of Giza and Sphinx

Rise & Shine! Start your day with breakfast at the hotel. Encounter the [Great Pyramids](#), [the Sphinx](#), and a camel ride at Giza Plateau your Egyptologist will immerse you in these wonders of the world, and he will do everything for you and your family. You will just enjoy the vibe.

Day 4

Day 5

Valley of the Kings and Luxor Museum

You can stop at the Luxor Museum to see its fabulous collection of pottery, jewelry, furniture, and statuary.
