Day 1

Take in the incredible Light and Sound show at the Philae Temple as the sun sets. Attending this popular event will offer you an outstanding night for only \$45.00 per person.

Day 2

Kom Ombo – Edfu & Onward

Following that is the majestic Kom Ombo temple dedicated to Horus and Sobek. We're on the journey to Edfu, adjacent to the Temple of Horus, Egypt's best-preserved temple. We'll keep going till we reach Luxor.

Overnight: Onboard the Nile Cruise | **Meals:** Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner.

Day 3

Luxor Top Attraction: West Bank

We'll start the day with a hearty breakfast before touring Luxor's sights. We're passing through Luxor en route to the West Bank's ancient sites.

Three essential ancient landmarks include the Valley of the Kings, the enormous Colossi of Memnon on the West Bank, and the gorgeous Temple of Queen Hatshepsut.

Optional tour:

Take a hot air balloon ride above Luxor and soak in the spectacular views below. A group of five to eight persons will be charged USD 220 per person.

Day 4

Check Out - Luxor's Eastern Bank

Day 3

Edfu & Kom Ombo

We rose early to see the majestic Edfu temple. This massive architectural work of art, dedicated to the falcon deity Horus, houses some of the world's most valuable and costly stones. We arrive at the magnificent Temple of Edfu just before dawn. This historical place offers an unusual glimpse into the past. Horus, the most wealthy falcon deity, lies here.

We'll need an ample breakfast before going to the renowned Kom Ombo. Horus the Elder, also known as Haroeis, the Falcon God, is honored with a temple. The opposite side is represented by the

Crocodile, Sobek, the cosmic creator and fertility deity. Finish the day with a beautiful night after a delicious supper and fascinating historical sights.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner.

Day 4

Aswan - High Dam and Philae Temple

The magnificent Nile waves meet us at Aswan. Before you bid farewell to your adventure, enjoy your meal.

Our route includes visits to the well-known Philae Temple, the Unfinished Obelisk, and the breathtaking High Dam. After a substantial lunch, sit back and enjoy the surroundings.

Optional tour:

Take the Felucca Ride voyage to Elephantine Island, a famous Egyptian landmark and one of Aswan's islands. Five to eight persons will pay a total of USD 130.00.
