Day 6

Abu Simbel

Immerse yourself in ancient Egyptian history on a tour of <u>Abu Simbel</u> <u>temples</u> south of Aswan. The awe-inspiring temples of Abu Simbel are a testament to the grandeur of the pharaohs. With our expert Egyptologist guide, you'll learn about their fascinating history.

The Temple of Ramses II and the smaller Temple of Hathor are two massive rock temples carved into the mountainside during the 13th century BC. They were initially built to commemorate Pharaoh
Ramses II's victory at the Battle of Kadesh and to intimidate the neighboring Nubians.

Due to the Aswan High Dam construction and the resulting creation of Lake Nasser, the temples were relocated in 1968 to avoid being submerged. Today the Abu Simbel Temples are included in the "Nubian Monuments" UNESCO World Heritage Site. With our experienced guide, you'll explore the temples and discover the secrets of their construction. Learn about their rediscovery in the 19th century, and marvel at the stunning artwork and inscriptions that adorn their walls.

After a personalized tour of **Abu Simbel**, you'll fly back to Aswan, where you can reflect on your unforgettable journey through the heart of ancient Egypt.

Day 7

The Temple of Philae

Take a motorboat ride to the <u>Temple of Philae</u>, beautifully located on an island and dedicated to Isis, the goddess of health, marriage, and wisdom. Philae is considered one of the burial places of the god Osiris. Hence, the island was a sacred place for Ancient Egyptians.

The temple consists of monuments from various times extending from the Pharaohs to the Caesars. On a camel ride to the southern tip of **Elephantine Island**, you will find St Simeon's Monastery, an ancient, abandoned fortress mostly built during the 7th century and located near Aswan. The monastery was given the name St Simeon by archaeologists and travelers. Still, earlier Arabic and Coptic sources called it Anba Hedra, after an anchorite who was consecrated a bishop of Syene (now Aswan) by Patriarch Theophilus (385-412 AD).

Day 8

The Edfu Temple

Our cruise ship will take us to **Edfu** in the morning to see its marvelous temple. The **Edfu Temple** is the best-preserved ancient temple in Egypt dedicated to the falcon god Horus. It was built in the Ptolemaic period between 240 and 57 BC. Upon returning to the ship, we will cruise towards Kom Ombo and arrive in the late afternoon.

We will visit the Ptolemaic Kom Ombo Temple. It was built during King Ptolemy V's reign (ca. 205 to 180 BC). The Ptolemies constructed the **Temple of Kom Ombo** to worship the two gods, Sobek – the crocodile god, and Horus – the falcon god. After visiting the site, we will return to the ship for dinner and continue sailing north.

Day 9

Luxor Attractions

We will start sightseeing on Luxor's east and west banks that day. After breakfast, visit the attractions on the **East Bank** of Thebes. This remarkable city served as Egypt's capital during the Middle Kingdom and the peak of the New Kingdom. This extraordinary city was dedicated to Amun, one of the most revered Egyptian deities of the Egyptian Pantheon. Explore the Karnak Temple and Luxor Temple complex, home to a sprawling array of shrines, obelisks, and locations where Amun and other deities were worshiped. After having lunch, cross the Nile to the West Bank.

The <u>Valley of the Kings</u> has been the royal cemetery for 62 Pharaohs. Undeniably, it is one of Egypt's most important treasures. We will access some of the most famous tombs, including admission to King Tutankhamun's grave. You will visit the remarkable tomb of Queen Nefertari in the <u>Valley of Queens</u>.

The rest of the afternoon will be leisure-free when we return to the ship. Our guests can enjoy the sundeck and the stunning views of the Nile landscape.

Day 10

Head to Cairo

Disembark the ship and fly back to Cairo. **Fly back to Cairo** and explore the primary site of Cairo with a visit to the famous **Egyptian**

Museum. Housing over 65,000 Egyptian artifacts, the museum attracts millions of visitors annually. The highlights of the museum are the priceless treasures of King Tutankhamun. His six gold-gilded coffins dominate the main hall, while his magnificent gold mask is the star attraction! Your Egyptologist guide will introduce you to the most important pieces before allowing you to explore the museum at your leisure.

Day 11

Giza Pyramids and Sakkara

During your private tour of Egypt's most iconic landmarks, indulge in a once-in-a-lifetime experience and bask in personalized attention. With the freedom to customize your itinerary, you can dictate how long you spend at each site you visit. Marvel at the Great Pyramids and Sphinx, structures that have stood the test for over 4600 years on the Giza plateau. Out of the over 100 pyramids scattered across Egypt, the Pyramids of Giza remain the most renowned and are considered the last of the ancient Seven Wonders of the World. Your knowledgeable Egyptologist guide will provide a captivating introduction to the three pyramids: Cheops, Chephren, and Mykerinus. You can even explore one of the pyramids alone during your free time (at an additional cost). However, your guide will not be allowed to accompany you.

After admiring the pyramids, continue your journey across the plateau, capturing breathtaking photos of the three pyramids as they emerge majestically from the sands, with the enchanting Cairo skyline as a stunning backdrop. A brief drive to the city side of the plateau will lead you to the Sphinx, an enigmatic symbol of Egypt that has puzzled

people for thousands of years. With a lion's body and a king's head, the Sphinx remains shrouded in mystery, including its builders and purpose.

Next, venture to <u>Sakkara</u>, the main graveyard of the old kingdom era and a renowned archaeological site where the legendary architect Imhotep built the oldest pyramid in Egypt. This first stone structure dated back 4800 years and was erected with enormous solid steps, aptly named the Step Pyramid. As you explore the complex, your guide will illuminate the development of the royal tomb structure. You will also have the rare opportunity to enter one of the nobles' tombs, the Tomb of Kagmini, and the Tomb of Ti, where you can marvel at the murals depicting daily life activities in ancient Egypt. As a highlight of your visit, enter the pyramid of Titi, where you can witness the oldest form of the pyramid text etched onto the chamber walls over 4340 years ago.

Old Cairo

Khan el Khalili Bazaar, which has captivated travelers for centuries.
