Day 1

We will enjoy a substantial breakfast before heading to the renowned Kom Ombo. A temple is devoted to Horus the Elder, also called Haroeis, the Falcon God, and the opposing side is marked as the Crocodile by Sobek, the cosmic creator and fertility deity. After a delicious meal and intriguing historical sites, round off the day with a superb evening.

Day 4

Aswan - High Dam and Philae Temple

The glorious Nile waves meet us at Aswan, have your breakfast as we near the end of this exceptional journey.
